Discussion of the new Ordinance BL2013-570. The Administrative Staff has had numerous electrical workers contact the Codes Staff providing documentation that does not pertain to the new classifications specified in the Ordinance: Journeyman Electrician, Apprentice Electrician, Beginning Electrician and Temporary License.

Karene West has had numerous conversations with the IBEQW, Board Member James Shaw and Business Manager of the IBEW, John Ledwell to gain clarification of documentation which the Codes Office has received. After many discussions, the Codes Staff had a clear understanding the license types and actual Certificates the IBEW provided would be accepted.

In a conversation with John Ledwell, the IBEW is now asking that we also accept other classifications and provide a license to these individuals that we do not find as part of the Ordinance. Mr. Ledwell asked to appear before the Board to provide clarification to the IBEW difference License types, as it was made clear that the Board of Electrical Examiners and Appeals had jurisdiction over such issues.
