NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

That the service enterprise initiative agreement by and between the Best Friends Animal Society and The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, acting by and through the Metropolitan Board of Health, to provide training and consulting for Service Enterprise Certification, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved.

Section 2. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.
