

**REF:** McGavock Pike proposed name change to "Knight Valley Dr"  
Map 120 & 134 / District 13

As I'm sure you are aware, there are several streets within Davidson County named McGavock Pike. There are two of these streets that run south off Murfreesboro Pike near the Airport. Emergency Communications advised us there have been routing issues in Emergency Dispatching caused by these two different streets with the same name having duplicate intersections.

District 13 Council Member, Holly Huezo, was contacted regarding this Enhanced 911 problem. The Council Member and Public Works would like to propose changing the name of McGavock Pike on the west side of the Airport Property to "Knight Valley Dr". This will alleviate the duplicate intersection problems for Dispatch and Emergency Services.

Attached is a portion of the Property Map showing the section of McGavock Pike that is requested to be renamed. Most of the adjacent properties are vacant parcels owned by the Metropolitan Nashville Airport Authority. One parcel is a Lease property (12015000500) and one Parcel is Owner occupied (12015001900). NES has a substation along this road (13400001801) and has been advised of the proposed street name change. The Post Office is in the process of building a new facility along this McGavock Pike (13400001300) and has also been told about the proposed street name change.
