Dear Ms. Fox:

As you are aware the Metropolitan Board of Parks and Recreation, on Tuesday, November 7, 2017, accepted a grant in the amount of \$75,000 to fund the following improvements in Green Hills Park:

- Grassy berms and a log obstacle course, to be located in the northwestern section of the Park, berms will be graded at a 3:1 pitch, to allow lawnmower access.
- Crepe myrtles in five clusters of three plants each, spaced at intervals of 12-15 feet over about two hundred running feet. These will run parallel to the northern side of the walking path.
- Split rail fencing, to replace the chain link fencing currently in place.
- Flower beds near the entrance to the park off Lone Oak.

The final details and locations for the stated improvements must be coordinated through staff of the Parks Maintenance Division prior to any installation. All installation will be performed in accordance with Parks' third party construction agreement. Fencing selected to replace current fencing must be in accordance with Metro Codes.




- Crepe myrtles in five clusters of three plants each, spaced at intervals of 12-15 feet over about two hundred running feet. These will run parallel to the northern side of the walking path, as shown in the **blue** rectangular block above.
- Split rail fencing, to replace the chain link fencing currently in place.
- Flower beds near the entrance to the park off Lone Oak.

The final details and locations for all of these improvements will be coordinated with and approved by Parks Department staff, prior to any installation. Installation will be done in accordance with Parks' third party construction agreement.

The estimated value of these donations is \$75,000. Friends of Green Hills Park will fund all the improvements. The Metropolitan Government will not be required to match any funds.

We appreciate your consideration very much, as we work to improve and beautify our neighborhood park.
