

RESOLUTION NO. RS2018-1036

A resolution amending BL2017-984, as amended, to authorize wrecker companies to charge a winching fee and to charge an increased storage fee.

WHEREAS, BL2017-984, as amended, approved a rate increase for towing and recovery rates, due to an increase in expenses for equipment, insurance, taxes and fuel; and,

WHEREAS, as approved, there is contradictory language with respect to charging a winching fee that requires clarification; and,

WHEREAS, currently, the maximum storage of any car or pickup truck removed from private property is thirty dollars per day, and per the wrecker company request to the Transportation Licensing Commission, which was approved, the storage fee should be increased from thirty dollars to forty dollars per day to reflect the increase in expenses for equipment, insurance, taxes and fuel; and,

WHEREAS, amendments to BL2017-984 may be approved by resolution of the Metropolitan Council; and,

WHEREAS, the amendments to Chapter 6.80 are in the best interest of the citizens of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That Chapter 6.80, subsection 6.80.550 (A)(1)(a), of the Metropolitan Code of Laws is amended by deleting the word “winching” and by adding the phrase, “unless otherwise authorized,” at the end of the paragraph.

Section 2. That Chapter 6.80, subsection 6.80.550 (A)(1)(b), of the Metropolitan Code of Laws is amended by deleting the word “winching” and by adding the phrase, “unless otherwise authorized,” at the end of the paragraph.

Section 3. That Chapter 6.80, subsection 6.80.550 (A)(1)(c), of the Metropolitan Code of Laws is amended by deleting the word “winching” and by adding the phrase, “unless otherwise authorized,” at the end of the paragraph.

Section 4. That Chapter 6.80, subsection 6.80.550 (A)(1)(d), of the Metropolitan Code of Laws is amended by deleting the word “winching” and by adding the phrase, “unless otherwise authorized,” at the end of the paragraph.

Section 5. That Chapter 6.80, subsection 6.80.550(H)(2), of the Metropolitan Code of Laws is amended deleting it in its entirety and replacing with the following:

“Storage. The maximum fee for storage of any vehicle removed from private property is forty dollars per day. No storage fee may be charged for cars or pickup trucks stored two hours or less.

Section 20. This resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.
