LOCAL AGENCY PROGRAM AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 20\_\_\_\_, by and between the STATE OF TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, an agency of the State of Tennessee (hereinafter called the "Department") and the City of Nashville (hereinafter called the "Agency").

W I T N E S S E T H:

WHEREAS, the Department desires to install a traffic signal within the jurisdictional limits of the Agency and

WHEREAS, the Agency, in recognition of the benefits to be received from the installation of said traffic signal desires to cooperate with the Department such that the traffic signal may be installed, operated and maintained;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of these premises, the Department and the Agency hereby enter into agreement to provide performance of the project.

SECTION I: The Project to be performed is described as follows:

"Installation of Fiber Optics, Controllers and Dedicated Short Range Communication Devices at Various Intersections under the jurisdiction of the Agency:

- A. Which the list of Intersections with Fiber Optics and Controllers appear as Attachment A and the maintenance of these are covered under Section II below.
- B. Which the list of intersections with the new Dedicated Short Range Communication Devices (DSRC) appear as Attachment B and the maintenance of these will be maintained by the Department for Five (5) years from integration at which time they will become the responsibility of the Agency to maintain.

SECTION II: The Agency shall be solely responsible for and pay all costs associated with maintenance and operation of all electrically operated devices together with the related equipment, wiring and other necessary appurtenances,

and the Agency shall furnish electrical current to all such devices which may be installed as part of the project. Additionally, the Agency shall be solely responsible for and pay all costs associated with the maintenance and operation of solar-powered devices, including, but not limited to, replacement of solar panels, batteries, lights and lenses.

SECTION III: The Agency agrees to comply with all applicable federal and state laws and regulations in the performance of its duties under this contract. The parties hereby agree that failure of the Agency to comply with this provision shall constitute a material breach of this agreement and subject the Agency to the repayment of all state funds expended, or expenses incurred, under this agreement.
