Dear D'Yuanna,

Congratulations once again to Metro Public Health Department (MPHD) on being awarded a March of Dimes Community Grant. You have been approved for the amount of \$25,000 for a time period of May 1, 2018 to March 31, 2019.

On October 31st, as agreed in your signed grant agreement, we received your mid-year progress report pertaining to your grant proposal to implement the One Key Question (OKQ) reproductive life planning model. Additionally, we received your narrative request for revisions to your originally approved grant proposal.

Our March of Dimes Regional and State Maternal Child Health Directors and Maternal Child Health volunteer leadership have reviewed your request outlining that the Tennessee Department of Health no longer wishes to implement OKQ and, instead, desires to implement the evidence-informed Parenthood/Pregnancy, Attitudes, Timing and How ("PATH") model.

After review of your narrative explanation and modification in your objectives, **you are hereby approved to continue the work of your community grant with modification to the scope of the signed grant agreement, which previously required that MPHD implement the evidenced-based OKQ model to now implement the evidenced-informed PATH model moving forward.**

Due to the varying delays in grant startup, we already anticipate that you will need to submit a request for a **no cost extension** as you near the end of your contract period. This is allowable and our staff and volunteer leaders will review that request once it is submitted. The remaining provisions of the signed grant agreement shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.






