

Resolution No. RS2019-1640

A resolution approving amendment one to a grant from the March of Dimes Foundation to The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, acting by and through the Metropolitan Board of Health, to promote increasing preconception and interconception education for women of childbearing age in Davidson County.

WHEREAS, The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, acting by and through the Metropolitan Board of Health, previously entered into a grant agreement with the March of Dimes Foundation to promote increasing preconception and interconception education for women of childbearing age in Davidson County approved by RS2018-1230; and,

WHEREAS, the parties wish to amend that grant agreement to no longer implement the One Key Question (OKQ) reproductive life planning model and instead implement the evidence-informed Parenthood/Pregnancy, Attitudes, Timing and How (PATH) model of reproductive planning; and,

WHEREAS, it is to the benefit of the citizens of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County that amendment one be accepted.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That amendment one to the grant by and between the March of Dimes Foundation and The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, acting by and through the Metropolitan Board of Health, to no longer implement the One Key Question (OKQ) reproductive life planning model and instead implement the evidence-informed Parenthood/Pregnancy, Attitudes, Timing and How (PATH) model of reproductive planning, a copy of which amendment one is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved, and the Metropolitan Mayor is authorized to execute the same.

Section 2. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.
