

ORDINANCE NO. BL2019-1647

An ordinance authorizing The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County to abandon existing easement rights and 111 linear feet of existing three inch water main located at 65 Lindsley Avenue, formerly known as Berrien Street (Proposal 2019M-031ES-001).

WHEREAS, easement rights that were retained by Council Bill O80-380, for any existing utilities located at 65 Lindsley Avenue, formerly known as Berrien Street, and 111 linear feet of existing three inch water main, are no longer needed; and,

WHEREAS, the abandonment has been requested by The Fuel Tank, LLC, owners; and,

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Planning Commission approved mandatory referral No. 2019M-031ES-001 on April 12, 2019, for the abandonment of said easement rights and water main.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County is authorized to abandon easement rights that were retained by Council Bill O80-380, for any existing utilities located at 65 Lindsley Avenue, formerly known as Berrien Street, and 111 linear feet of existing three inch water main, as shown below and on Exhibit 1, which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference.

Section 2. The Directors of Water and Sewerage Services and Public Property Administration are authorized to execute such documents as may be necessary and appropriate to carry out the abandonment authorized by this ordinance.

Section 3. Amendments to this legislation shall be approved by resolution.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its final passage, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.
