The Nashville Parks Foundation (NPF) requests approval to accept private donations up to \$500,000 for the development of Frankie Pierce Park. This gift will require no matching funds from the Metropolitan Government.

Frankie Pierce Park is currently under construction and is subject to the terms of an existing agreement between the Metropolitan Government and Capital View Joint Venture (CVJV), attached. 


