

**ORDINANCE NO. BL2019-1489**

**An Ordinance amending Section 12.62.060 of the Metropolitan Code of Laws pertaining to data collection from operators of shared urban mobility devices.**

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County currently permits owners and operators of shared urban mobility devices (SUMDs) to rent SUMDs in Nashville and Davidson County during a pilot period pursuant to Second Substitute Ordinance No. BL2018-1202; and

WHEREAS, parking SUMDs in areas and ways unauthorized by the Metropolitan Government poses health and safety risks and disrupts pedestrian activity; and

WHEREAS, it is proper for the Metropolitan Government to regulate activities which might cause unsafe conditions on public property; and

WHEREAS, sufficient data collection regarding the operation of SUMDs is necessary to adequately enforce parking regulations for SUMDs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That Section 12.62.060 is amended by adding the following new text as Subsection G, labelling the current Subsection G as Subsection H, and renumbering the remaining subsections as necessary:

G. Permitted operators shall also provide Metro ITS with parking photographs delivered by the user if such a photograph is otherwise required by the operator.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect from and after its enactment, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.
