

RESOLUTION NO. RS2019- 1867

A Resolution welcoming the 2019 Redmond Health and Safety Symposium and Barbera EMS Conference to Nashville.

WHEREAS, the International Association of Fire Fighters' 2019 Redmond Symposium and Barbera EMS Conference will be held August 18-22, 2019 in Nashville; and

WHEREAS, the John P. Redmond Symposium, first held in 1971, focuses on occupational health and safety hazards of the fire service. It features a combination of workshops, discussions, and exhibits designed to keep fire and emergency service professionals up to date on the latest strategies and tools for staying safer on the job; and

WHEREAS, the Dominick F. Barbera EMS Conference, first held as the EMS Conference in 1991, explores all aspects of fire-based emergency medical services and is designed to help improve the effectiveness of fire-based emergency medical services systems by providing the tools necessary to develop, enhance, and protect response capability and fire fighter/EMT and paramedic working conditions; and

WHEREAS, Fire fighters, paramedics, medical directors, physicians, occupational safety professionals and fitness trainers are invited to attend the conference, which includes two days of plenary sessions and two days of topic-specific workshops, briefings and information sessions; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper that the Metropolitan County Council hereby goes on record as welcoming the International Association of Fire Fighters' 2019 Redmond Health and Safety Symposium and Barbera EMS Conference to Nashville.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That the Metropolitan Council hereby goes on record as welcoming the 2019 Redmond Health and Safety Symposium and Barbera EMS Conference to Nashville.
