

RESOLUTION NO. RS2019 - 43

A resolution accepting a grant from Keep Tennessee Beautiful to The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, acting by and through the Metro Public Works Department, to implement a Cigarette Litter Prevention and Recycling campaign at Riverfront Park.

WHEREAS, Keep Tennessee Beautiful has awarded a grant in an amount not to exceed \$5,000.00 with no cash match required to The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, acting by and through the Metro Public Works Department, to implement a Cigarette Litter Prevention and Recycling campaign at Riverfront Park; and,

WHEREAS, it is to the benefit of the citizens of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County that this grant be accepted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That the grant by and between Keep Tennessee Beautiful, in an amount not to exceed \$5,000.00, to The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, acting by and through the Metro Public Works Department, to implement a Cigarette Litter Prevention and Recycling campaign at Riverfront Park, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the amount of this grant be appropriated to the Metro Public Works Department based on revenues estimated to be received and any match to be applied.

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.
