

ORDINANCE NO. BL2019 - 57

An ordinance authorizing The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County to abandon existing public water and sanitary sewer mains and easements, to raise existing sanitary sewer manhole rims, and to accept new water and sanitary sewer mains, fire hydrant assemblies, sanitary sewer manholes and easements, for property located at 1501 Hillside Avenue (MWS Project Nos. 19-WL-061 and 19-SL-101 and Proposal No. 2019M-070ES-001).

WHEREAS, the abandonment of approximately 72 linear feet of existing six inch water main, approximately 107 linear feet of existing 24 inch water main, approximately 153 linear feet of existing eight inch sanitary sewer main and easements, the raising of two sanitary sewer manhole rims, and the acceptance of approximately 14 linear feet of new six inch water main (DIP), approximately 113 linear feet of new 24 inch water main (DIP), approximately 149 linear feet of new eight inch sanitary sewer main (DIP), three fire hydrant assemblies, two sanitary sewer manholes and easements, for property located at 1501 Hillside Avenue, are needed to construct project numbers 19-WL-061 and 19-SL-101; and,

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Planning Commission approved mandatory referral No. 2019M-070ES-001 on October 9, 2019, for the abandonment, raising and acceptance of said water and sanitary sewer mains, fire hydrant assemblies, sanitary sewer manholes and easements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County is authorized to abandon approximately 72 linear feet of existing six inch water main, approximately 107 linear feet of existing 24 inch water main, approximately 153 linear feet of existing eight inch sanitary sewer main and easements, to raise two sanitary sewer manhole rims, and to accept approximately 14 linear feet of new six inch water main (DIP), approximately 113 linear feet of new 24 inch water main (DIP), approximately 149 linear feet of new eight inch sanitary sewer main (DIP), three fire hydrant assemblies, two sanitary sewer manholes and easements, for property located at 1501 Hillside Avenue, as shown on Exhibit 1, which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference.

Section 2. The Directors of Water and Sewerage Services and Public Property Administration are authorized to execute such documents as may be necessary and appropriate to carry out the abandonment, raising and acceptance authorized by this ordinance.




Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its final passage, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.




