

ORDINANCE NO. BL2019 - 81

An ordinance authorizing The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County to abandon existing public sanitary sewer main and easements and to accept new sanitary sewer mains, sanitary sewer manholes, fire hydrant assembly and easements, for properties located at 1111 Gallatin Avenue and 1100B Greenwood Avenue (MWS Project Nos. 19-SL-128 and 19-WL-58 and Proposal No. 2019M-069ES-001).

WHEREAS, the abandonment of approximately 103 linear feet of existing 12 inch sanitary sewer main (VCP) and easements, and the acceptance of approximately 90 linear feet of new eight inch sanitary sewer main (PVC), approximately 83 linear feet of new 12 inch sanitary sewer main (PVC), approximately 41 linear feet of new 12 inch sanitary sewer main (DIP), three sanitary sewer manholes, one fire hydrant assembly and easements, for properties located at 1111 Gallatin Avenue and 1100B Greenwood Avenue, are needed to construct project numbers 19-SL-128 and 19-WL-58; and,

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Planning Commission approved mandatory referral No. 2019M-069ES-001 on October 7 2019, for the abandonment and acceptance of said sanitary sewer mains, sanitary sewer manholes, fire hydrant assembly and easements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County is authorized to abandon approximately 103 linear feet of existing 12 inch sanitary sewer main (VCP) and easements, and to accept approximately 90 linear feet of new eight inch sanitary sewer main (PVC), approximately 83 linear feet of new 12 inch sanitary sewer main (PVC), approximately 41 linear feet of new 12 inch sanitary sewer main (DIP), three sanitary sewer manholes, one fire hydrant assembly and easements, for properties located at 1111 Gallatin Avenue and 1100B Greenwood Avenue, as shown on Exhibit 1, which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference.

Section 2. The Directors of Water and Sewerage Services and Public Property Administration are authorized to execute such documents as may be necessary and appropriate to carry out the abandonment and acceptance authorized by this ordinance.

Section 3. Amendments to this legislation shall be approved by resolution.


Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its final passage, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.


