

ORDINANCE NO. BL2019 - 84

An ordinance authorizing The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County to accept new sanitary sewer main, sanitary sewer manholes, and easements, for three properties located at 1020 C Old Hickory Boulevard and New Providence Pass (unnumbered) (MWS Project No. 19-SL-92 and Proposal No. 2019M-075ES-001).

WHEREAS, the acceptance of approximately 1,769 linear feet of new eight inch sanitary sewer main (PVC), 15 sanitary sewer manholes and easements, for three properties located at 1020 C Old Hickory Boulevard and New Providence Pass (unnumbered), are needed to construct project number 19-SL-92; and,

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Planning Commission approved mandatory referral No. 2019M-075ES-001 on October 16, 2019, for the acceptance of said sanitary sewer main, sanitary sewer manholes, and easements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County is authorized to accept approximately 1,769 linear feet of new eight inch sanitary sewer main (PVC), 15 sanitary sewer manholes and easements, for three properties located at 1020 C Old Hickory Boulevard and New Providence Pass (unnumbered), as shown on Exhibit 1, which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference.






