




## Notice of Intersection Improvements

On July 12, 2010, the Metro Department of Public Works' contractor started work on improvements to the intersection of Antioch Pike and Richards Road.



The improvements include removal and replacement of the span wire traffic signal with a mast arm traffic signal configuration. The work zone will primarily be limited to the intersection areas. Some temporary lane closures can be expected.

In general, working hours will be from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. on weekdays; some work may occur on weekends and at night between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. to minimize disruptions. Depending on weather, estimated completion of the project is November 2010.
