




## Notice of Intersection Improvements

On July 26, 2010, the Metro Department of Public Works plans to begin work on improvements to the intersection of Harding Place and Trousdale Drive.



The improvements include lane modifications on the north leg of Trousdale Dr., addition of a second eastbound left turn lane on Harding Place, modifications to the concrete islands, improvements to the pedestrian facilities, traffic signal modifications, milling and repaving, and new pavement markings. The work zone will primarily be limited to the intersection areas. Some temporary lane closures can be expected.

In general, working hours will be from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. on weekdays; some work may occur on weekends and at night between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. to minimize disruptions. Depending on weather, estimated completion of the project is September 2010.
