FREE SHRED DAY YIELDS OVER FIVE TONS OF DOCUMENTS AND PEACE OF MIND FOR MANY METRO RESIDENTS

On Saturday, November 3, Metro Beautification and Iron Mountain Inc. sponsored a free community shred day for residents and small businesses in Davidson County and surrounding areas.
