Firm's proposal failed to demonstrate a clear understanding of the scope of work for this solicitation. Firm failed to provide resumes for two (2) key team members. Firm's proposal lacked detail in project management and project engagement. Reference projects lacked detetails. Firm's proposal formatting was not titled or sectioned. No samples were submitted.

Strengths

Firm's proposal demonstrated a clear understanding of scope of work for this solicitation. LEED certification process. Firm's proposal demonstrated and provided all other required information with the exception of the weaknesses noted below.

Weaknesses

Firm's proposal lacked detail for design phase activities. Response on how appropriate level of commissioning is determined lacked detail.

Technical Assurance Inc

Strengths

Firm's proposal demonstrated and provided all other required information with the exception of the weaknesses noted below.

Weaknesses

Firm's proposal demonstratrated firm relys heavily on ABES for practice, site visits and services of Kristy Cobb, experience limited to roofing assessments. Failed to demonstrate team experience relevant to scope of work. Failed to demonstrate understanding of scope of work. Only one reference project was of similar size, scope and complexity. LEED documentation lacked detail.

Terracon

Strengths

Early design phase discussion. Demonstrated relevant team qualifications. Provided detailed reference projects. Demonstrated process of determing appropriate level of commissioning. Firm's proposal demonstrated and provided all other required information with the exception of the weaknesses noted below.

Weaknesses

Firm's organizational chart was unclear in terms of team member roles. Firm's LEED experience lacked detail.
