To discuss a request to amend the West Nashville Community Plan, by changing land use policy for property located along Cowden Ave., south of Charlotte Pk. The plan amendment area is shown on the map on the back of this notice. The request would change the land use policy from Suburban Neighborhood Evolving (T3 NE) to Suburban Mixed Use Corridor (T3 CM) policy.

<u>WHAT IS A COMMUNITY PLAN?</u> Community Plans guide future growth and preservation decisions made by Metro government. This includes recommendations to Metro Council on zone change requests. <u>WHAT IS THE CURRENT COMMUNITY PLAN (LAND USE) POLICY?</u> The current policy for the plan amendment area is Suburban Neighborhood Evolving (T3 NE). This policy is intended to enhance and create suburban residential neighborhoods with more housing choices, improved pedestrian, bicycle, and vehicular connectivity, and moderate density development patterns.


WHAT CHANGES ARE PROPOSED? (SEE MAP ON REVERSE FOR MORE DETAIL) The plan amendment request would change the policy for the property at 6111 Cowden Ave. from T3 NE to Suburban Mixed Use Corridor (T3 CM) policy (outlined on the map). This change would add this property to the surrounding T3 CM policy area. T3 CM policy encourages a mix of uses, including higher density residential, along the corridor.

<u>WHY ARE THESE CHANGES PROPOSED?</u> This request is associated with a zone change request 2021Z-077PR-001 for 6111 Cowden Ave. from R6 (single and two-family) to OR20 (office and residential) to add this property to the adjacent business. The current land use policy does not support non-residential zoning; therefore, this change in land use policy has been requested.
