- Call for extra items to review beyond existing plans, prominent sites and transportation projects within the study area. No additional items were mentioned.
- Identification of TDOT programmed projects and local projects.
- Key considerations:
 - Connections to Downtown
 - Connectivity to neighborhoods
 - Complement Envision Cayce
 - North-South Connectivity Needs
 - Greenway Connections
 - Equitable Investments
 - Plan for All Modes
 - Including Micro-mobility and Emerging Modes
 - Plan for Multiple Trip Purposes
- Mobility design principles:
 - Ellington Parkway extension onto site
 - Main St and Woodland Ave are key corridors and addressing streets
 - North-South
 - Bus loop through East Bank neighborhood

Riverfront and Resiliency

- Understanding 2010 flood
 - 2010 Flood - Storm System Stalled And Primarily Fell In Unregulated Stretches Of The Cumberland River Basin Upstream. Flooding Primarily Caused River Overtopping.
 - 13.57 Inches Fell In Two Days (36 Hours)
 - Flood Crest - 51.86 Stage (+419.31 Ft NAVD 88)

- Current Trend Is For More Intense Storm Events With No Significant Increase In Annual Precipitation
- Water came to within 6" of overtopping the dam
Dams were not designed for flood control
10-12' rise in 30 minutes
- River Traffic and use:
 - Barge traffic is expected to increase
 - 70% of Nashville's fuel supply is from the Colonial Pipeline
 - As a result of the recent crisis, the limitations of the pipeline became apparent
