Madison Station Blvd Project

Rain delayed work on site yesterday. Roadway work continues adjacent to Hardees. The last segment of sidewalk between the retaining wall near Hardees and the west side of Fifty Forward is being poured. Grading for drainage is taking place near Fifty Forward. A failed section of bike path was removed and is being prepared for replacement. The headwall on the west side of pond in being constructed. Underground electrical installations are being completed. Work continues on light pole foundations, conduit and wire installations. Sidewalk adjacent to Hardee's retaining wall has been installed and the adjacent bike path is also being constructed. Slopes adjacent to Madison Square has been seeded and strawed.

North Nashville - Capital Bikeways Project

Work accomplished 9/11/21 - 9/17/21:

PRI completed the installation of GREEN MMA and the WHITE symbols on the MMA on 28th Ave N.

Two-Week look ahead as weather allows:

- There is no work planned on NNB (other than warranty repairs) until Monroe St starts. This will be the last project update until work begins on Monroe
- We do not have a schedule for Special Operations to begin milling on Monroe St at this time.

Projects Underway the Week of 9/20/2021 - 9/24/2021

KEY			
Casting Adjustments Adjustment (lowering) of utilities to allow milling machines to traverse the roadway without damaging utility assets. Reference (raising) of utilities so that they will again be flush with the new surface that will be applied.			
Milling/Undercutting Removal (milling) of old surface using a milling machine. All milled surfaces must be cleaned by the milling contract appropriately to safely direct traffic. During undercutting the old surface that has failed is cut out and new material before it is resurfaced.			
Infrared	A technique where infrared heating systems apply heat to pavement surfaces and aid in the removal of existing material and replacement with new asphalt mixture.		
Signal Loop Wires	Signal Loop Wires are installed under the pavement. They are used to detect vehicles passing or arriving at a traffic light.		
Crack Seal	A sealant put into the construction joint to keep water out so the road will not depreciate.		
Fog Seal	A sealing put on the road to give the road an extended period before it gets paved.
