They picked up where the prior meeting had left off and discussed each step and determined for each action whether to keep it, whether not to keep it, or whether to defer it.

A lot of discussion was held around where certain action steps belong, especially since some of them touched different goals.

The group decided to create language about who needs to be involved to help implement the strategic plan. Rather than list partners in separate action steps, they decided it will be more helpful to create language about the partners and initiatives that need to be included to implement this plan.
