The group reviewed and discussed the detailed actions under Goal 1: Optimize All Resources

Detailed actions were prioritized by voting yes, no, or “defer to other Goal.”

There was comprehensive discussion around inventory identification, with the decision to consolidate any inventory-taking actions into one line item and add an action to evaluate inventory for effectiveness.

The group also discussed the need to identify and focus on systematic housing costs (transition, moving, support services costs) in addition to just inventory of housing and support services.

The conversation progressed to actions related to creating and maximizing resources where the group determined that a line item addressing transition to permanent housing support is necessary, and that the inventory and evaluation in Action 1 of this Goal should determine which most vulnerable populations will be prioritized.
