Strengths & Weaknesses

Barge Design Solutions

Strengths: Firm demonstrated their knowledge and related project experience in performing the services being requested on projects of similar scope using software tools and modeling. Firm demonstrated why their team is best suited for the project including benefits specific to this project. Firm provided an organizational chart that clearly defined the team structure including how the team is managed and corresponding team relationships. Firm described in detail how this project would be approached including major tasks and sub tasks. Firm included details on how work is to be performed for Metro prioritized within their company's current capacity.

<u>Weaknesses:</u> Firm did not demonstrate related project experience in performing green infrastructure services and city growth. Individual team members lack experience. Firm did not provide a minimum of five (5) projects of similar scope.

Brown and Caldwell

<u>Strengths:</u> Firm demonstrated their knowledge and related project experience in performing the services being requested on projects of similar scope. Firm provided detailed resumes of individual team members that demonstrated their qualifications related to the scope. Firm demonstrated their capacity and systems to coordinate their services and these efforts utilizing public outreach.

<u>Weaknesses:</u> Firm did not demonstrate why their teams best suited for the project including benefits specific to this project. Firm did not demonstrate local availability of staff/team members. Individual team members lack experience. Firm did not provide a minimum of five (5) projects of similar scope.

CDM Smith

<u>Strengths:</u> Firm demonstrated their knowledge and related project experience in performing the services being requested on projects of similar scope. Firm provided a minimum of five (5) projects of similar scope. Firm demonstrated their capacity and systems to coordinate their services to be provided under this solicitation regarding how they would deal with potential climate changes.

<u>Weaknesses:</u> Firm's anticipated percentage of time to be dedicated to the scope of services by Team Lead. Firm did not demonstrate related project experience in performing the project related to cost estimating and city growth. Firm did not demonstrate why their team is best suited for the project including benefits specific to this project.

Hazen and Sawyer

<u>Strengths:</u> Firm demonstrated their knowledge and related project experience in performing the services being requested on projects of similar scope. Firm identified a unique plan to accommodate climate change.

<u>Weaknesses:</u> Firm did not demonstrate local availability of staff/team members. Firm's individual team members lacked details related to qualifications and specialized expertise. Firm did not adequately explain how individual qualification and specialized expertise is related to the proposed scope of work. Firm did not provide adequate assurances that firm would have the appropriate staff available throughout the duration of the project. Firm did not provide a minimum of five (5) projects of similar scope. Firm's approach did not include plans to accommodate green infrastucture, flow monitoring and city growth.

SMITH SECKMAN REID INC

<u>Strengths:</u> Firm demonstrated local availability of staff/team members. Firm provided an organizational chart that clearly defined the team structure including how the team is managed and corresponding team relationships. Firm identified unique plan to deal accommodate flowmeters.

<u>Weaknesses:</u> Firm did not demonstrate their knowledge and related project experience on performing the services being requested on projects of similar scope. Firm did not provide a statement of their team. Firm did not demonstrate team detailed related to qualifications and specialized expertise, how individual qualifications and specialized expertise is related to the proposed scope and percentage of time to be dedicated to the scope. Firm's minimum of five (5) project summaries were not of similar scope. Firm's description of how the project will be approached lacked details on their approach to minimizing any disruptions to performance.

Wood Environment & Infrastructure

<u>Strengths:</u> Firm demonstrated why their team is best suited for the project including benefits specific to this project. Firm provided detailed defined responsibilities that demonstrate a connection with the tasked scope of services. Firm described in detail how this project would be approached including major tasks and sub tasks. Firm demonstrated their capacity and systems to coordinate their services and these efforts utilizing public outreach.

Weaknesses: Firm did not demonstrate their knowledge and related project experience on performing the services being requested specific to forecasting, modeling and program management. Firm did not provide adequate details related to the qualifications and specialized expertise in master planning. Firm's minimum of five (5) project summaries were not of similar scope. Firm did not demonstrate their capacity and systems to coordinate their services and these efforts related to scope.
