<u>STEP I</u>

Applications are to be submitted to the Department of Codes Administration. Incomplete applications <u>will not</u> be accepted.

STEP II

Upon receipt of your application, it will be reviewed and considered by the Mechanical Chief Inspector.

Upon approval you will receive notification by mail. We will include copies of the Examination Summary, Study Guide references and sample questions. The reference books needed are the latest editions of the Standard Mechanical Code and the Standard Gas Code.
