The MBOE will convene and Hearing Officers will begin to hear appeals on June 1, 2021. Appeal hearings are by appointment only and are scheduled by our office from May 24, 2021 until the deadline of June 25, 2021. You may schedule an appointment by calling (615)862-6059 weekdays between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. CDT.

Failure to appeal the assessment to the MBOE may result in the assessment becoming final without further right of appeal.
