<u>Strengths:</u> Firm adequately demonstrated that firm's key individuals who will be involved in providing the services have specialized knowledge that will provide services required in the scope of work. Firm provided evidence of expertise/knowledge regarding Metro Water Service facilities as related to this project. Firm adequately described their policies for ensuring the project will be environmentally friendly. Firm provided 5 referenced projects of similar size and scope that were completed on time and on budget and adequated described their successes and quantifiable results.

<u>Weaknesses:</u> Firm did not adequately demonstrate their project team has broad knowledge of solar. Firm did not adequately describe projects where they collaborated with their subcontractors. Firm did not identify in detail potential risks associated with execution of this contract. Firm did not adequately decribe how they addressed risks and challenges during 5 similar projects.
