Evaluation Comments

DLR Group Inc

Strengths

Proposal demonstrated firm's experience working with juvenile court residential facilities. Proposal provided a detailed best practices plan. Proposal demonstrated firm's scope of work experience on 100+ justice projects. Proposal demonstrated firm's leadership and experience for setting industry bench marks for excellence. Proposal provided a detailed values framework plan to include traffic engineer, with proposed analysis. Proposal provided a detailed plan for multi-modal traffic opportunities, value design, design to budget, and management in early design phase. Firm proposed early collaboration with CMAR. Proposal demonstrated firm's knowledge and experience with trauma informed and family oriented facilities. Proposal provided detailed list of challenges with resolutions. Proposal provided detailed plans for energy performance, change plan (to include visioning for the community), management plan, and integrated design. Proposal demonstrated firm's alignment with NYCE. Firm's proposal demonstrated and provided all other required information with the exception of the weaknesses noted below.

Weaknesses

Proposal was unclear demonstrating proposed project manager's role responsibilities on reference projects. Firm's organizational chart lacked details. Firm's subcontractor's experience was unclear. Firm's LEED projects lacked detail. Proposal failed to demonstrate sub-consultant's experience on local projects. Firm's proposed project manager is listed on another large project that is noted to end 2025, which leads to Metro's concern for capacity to perform. Proposal failed to demonstrate team diversity.

Hellmuth Obata & Kassabaum Inc.

Strengths

Proposal demonstrated firm's strong consulting pool. Proposal demonstrated firm's past team collaboration with subcontractors/consultants. Proposal demonstrated team diversity. Proposal demonstrated firm's experience with Metro projects, CJC projects, and police related projects. Proposal demonstrated firm's understanding of operational cost to construction costs. Proposal demonstrated firm's experience in evidence based design. Firm's proposal demonstrated and provided all other required information with the exception of the weaknesses noted below.

Weaknesses

Proposal demonstrated firm's limited experience with juvenile courts. Proposal focused more on correction/detention facilities. Proposal was unclear demonstrating firm's proposed team's role for the family safety center reference project. Proposal lacked detail demonstrating CMAR experience. Firm proposed design to cost approach, which is not acceptable to Metro. Proposal lacked detail for campus approach design plan. Proposal lacked detail demonstrated firm's experience with secured facilities. Firm's proposed low percentage of time for planning and design. Proposal demonstrated a heavy specialized staff during construction phase. Proposal was unclear and lacked detail for quality control and quality assurance plans. Proposal lacked detail for value engineering plan, and risk and energy performance. Firm's proposed management plan focused on security. firm's response for litigation was unclear and lacked detail.

TMPartners PLLC

Strengths

Firm provided a detailed organizational chart. Proposal demonstrated team diversity. Proposal demonstrated firm's strong consulting pool. Proposal demonstrated firm's experience on LEED projects. Proposal demonstrated firm's experience with trauma informed facilities. Reference projects provided were of similar size, scope and complexity. Proposal provided detailed plans for the use of judge testes, and creativity. Firm provided a detailed litigation response. Firm's proposed construction plans include trauma informed staff and relates to families that will utilize facility. Proposal demonstrated firm's understanding of a therapeutic environment and the affect the space has on youth. Firm's proposal demonstrated and provided all other required information with the exception of the weaknesses noted below.

Weaknesses

Proposal lacked detail demonstrating firm's qualifications for scope of work. Proposal demonstrated limited juvenile and court house experience. Proposal lacked detail demonstrating project experience. Proposal lacked detail demonstrating design and CA services experience. Proposal was unclear and lacked detail demonstrating juvenile justice consulting experience. Proposal lacked detail demonstrating energy performance plans, narrative lacked detail for metrics to validate performance. Proposal failed to demonstrate firm's understanding of JJC vision.
