Neighborhood Clean-Ups

Nashville is proud to be an affiliate of Keep America Beautiful Inc. The Keep America Beautiful- <u>Great American Cleanup</u> is a yearly event which began on Monday, March 21 and ended on Wednesday, June 22. During this time, NDOT facilitated 128 cleanups with 1,918 volunteers logging 5,404 volunteer hours and collecting 74 tons of litter. Harding Place @ Harding Pike Culvert Repair Project beginning on Saturday, July 9 What you need to know:

- The culvert replacement project will require a road closure from Saturday, July 9 through Monday, July 11 due to the depth of excavation, as well as the heavy traffic volume in the area.
- Work will be performed around the clock throughout the weekend of July 9 through July 11 and some lanes will reopen the following week as work continues during normal hours.
- The total anticipated project duration is twelve (12) days, weather dependent.

Madison Station Blvd Complete and Green Street Project

Completed the driveway and curb & gutter at the Beauty Supply Shop and the Culture Bar businesses. Completed project curb inlets on Madison Station Blvd. Completed sidewalk and ramp at Cal's Kitchen. Installed Bioretention soil from Madison St to Woodruff Intersection. Backfilled dirt along sidewalk from Madison St to Woodruff Intersection. Installation of mainline irrigation and sleeves from Woodruff St to Old Hickory Blvd are in progress. Currently installing sprinkler heads from Madison St to Woodruff Intersection. Installation of solar lights in in sidewalks are complete.



12th Ave South Complete and Green Street Project

Accomplishments:

- Excavated and poured curb islands up to just short of Edgehill.
- Cleared catch basin obstructions to remedy ponding.
- Surveying completed for outside lane islands all the way through phase 3.
- Surveying complete in phase 1 for storm water work, marked in pink paint.

Look Ahead:

- Excavate and pour curb islands across and southward from Edgehill into the phase 2 section.
- Catch basin clearing.
- Surveying progress for storm water work

Paving

Notice of milling and paving on a Metro roadway is required to be handled by the contractor via door hanger or mailing prior to the commencement of the project. Additional notification is required to be presented to the homeowner if a construction sign is going to be placed on their property. Report any violations directly to hubNashville [hub.Nashville.gov].

- <u>2022 Spring Paving Projects</u> These projects were funded in 2021 and will be completed this spring before we begin work on the Summer 2022 Paving Projects.
- <u>2022 Summer Paving Projects</u> Summer 2022 paving is expected to begin in late March/early April, weather dependent.

NOTE: All paving projects are weather dependent.

Roadway Closures Information

The right-of-way closures map allows the public to see where street, lane and sidewalk closures exist. It also allows motorist to plan their routes based upon active lane and street closures. *The map is updated every two hours*. Projects Underway the Week of 7/3/2022 - 7/9/2022

KEY	
Casting Adjustments	Adjustment (lowering) of utilities to allow milling machines to traverse the roadway without damaging utility assets. Re-adjustment (raising) of utilities so that they will again be flush with the new surface that will be applied.
Milling/Undercutting	Removal (milling) of old surface using a milling machine. All milled surfaces must be cleaned by the milling contractor and marked appropriately to safely direct traffic. During undercutting the old surface that has failed is cut out and new material is put back in before it is resurfaced.
Infrared	A technique where infrared heating systems apply heat to pavement surfaces and aid in the removal of existing material and replacement with new asphalt mixture.
Signal Loop Wires	Signal Loop Wires are installed under the pavement. They are used to detect vehicles passing or arriving at a traffic light.
Crack Seal	A sealant put into the construction joint to keep water out so the road will not depreciate.
Fog Seal	A sealing put on the road to give the road an extended period before it gets paved.


