ARTS

1 / Hartman Park Arts Project
\$399,000
Public art installations to enhance Hartman Park campus.

2 / Bordeaux Gateway Beautification & Art
\$210,000
Enhance the existing 'Welcome to Bordeaux' signage with a gateway artwork project.

3 / Bordeaux Library Corridor Arts Project
\$68,250
Celebrate reading and healthy living at Bordeaux Library with colorful interior art murals and artist designed bike rack.

4 / Looby Community Center and Library Revitalization
\$210,000
Feature a healthy living and art mural at Z. Alexander Looby Library; add community garden for environmental education and new outdoor seating.

EDUCATION

5 / Bordeaux Library Land Acquisition
\$194,250
Acquisition of land located next to the Bordeaux Library with the purpose of securing property to allow for future expansions. This would add 33% more square footage to the current area.

6 / Playground Equipment for Preschoolers
\$105,000
Install new playground for Preschool children at Ivanetta H. Davis Early Learning Center

7 / Improvements to Pearl-Cohn High School
\$472,500
New separate HVAC unit for the auxiliary gym at Pearl-Cohn High School and a filtered water unit for Pearl-Cohn practice field.

8 / Outdoor space at Pearl-Cohn High School
\$265,500
Addition of a multi-purpose building to be used by various clubs, after school groups, and community engagement.

SAFETY

9 / Speed Cushions Snell Boulevard and Panorama Drive
\$39,753
Installation of speed cushions in the Bordeaux Neighborhood on Snell Boulevard and Panorama Drive as a traffic calming measure to reduce overall speeding and increase safety.

10 / Speed cushions on Haynes Park Drive, Kingsview Drive and East Fairview Drive
\$56,360
Help keep our community safe and increase road safety; reduce speed and accidents; and control sudden increase in traffic volume.

SAFETY

11 / Traffic Calming in Historic North Nashville
\$40,267

Installation of speed cushions in Historic North Nashville neighborhoods (9th through 17th Avenues from Buchanan to Clay Street; Buchanan through Elizabeth Park) as a traffic calming measure to reduce overall speeding and increase safety.

12 / West Nocturne Drive Speed Control
\$24,885

Install speed cushions and speed limit indicators on West Nocturne Drive between Whites Creek Pike and Walker Lane to enforce the 25 miles per hour speed limit and increase safety for pedestrians and bicyclists that travel on the hilly and winding residential road.

13 / Speed Cushions on Putnam Drive and Lunn Drive
\$34,177

Install speed cushions with associated signage to help calm traffic along Putnam Drive and Lunn Drive.

14 / Osage Street Traffic Calming
\$104,202

Install speed cushions on Osage Street for the traffic calming safety of residents and pedestrians.

PARKS

15 / Improvements to Elizabeth Park
\$525,000

Improve Elizabeth Park with children’s playground equipment and a shade structure to help shield from the elements. Playground equipment would include swing sets, merry-go-round, and other types of exercise friendly equipment.

16 / Replace Restrooms in Fisk Park
\$787,000

Breathe fresh air into the Fisk Park experience by renovating the restrooms including addition of heating and ventilation systems.

17 / Beautification of Hadley Park
\$42,000

Removal of overgrown areas and replace with colorful native flower gardens. Enhance current landscaping with exterior lighting and timed irrigation system.

18 / Improve Hartman Park
\$84,000

Make Hartman Park a place for new adventures with the addition of an interactive chalk wall; keep the park clean with more trash receptacles.

19 / Improvements to Looby Park
\$420,000

Improve Looby Park with the addition of a spacious pavilion and by updating the restrooms.

20 / Improvements to Ted Rhodes Park
\$682,500

Improve and grade the football field area and add two scoreboards for football games.

21 / Fitness and Family Upgrades at Timothy Park
\$467,250

Build an outdoor pavilion shelter. Install outdoor fitness equipment on a synthetic surface. Add creative landscaping with native flower gardens. Improve the water retention area.

22 / Beautification and Improvement of White’s Creek Park
\$1,102,500

Enhance the park by adding a pavilion for community gatherings with accessible restrooms. Post signage to highlight the historical significance of the Trail of Tears.

23 / Improvements to Ted Rhodes Park Restroom Facility
\$787,500

Replace modular restroom with permanent modern restroom facility with sufficient privacy stalls and family only restrooms.

TRANSIT

24 / Bus Shelter 300 feet from 4007 Clarksville Hwy.
\$63,000

Install a new bus shelter close to the new Nashville Health Center (under construction) on Clarksville Highway with handicap accessibility.

STORM WATER

25 / Upgrades to Moormans Arm Rd/ Whites Creek Pike Drains
\$525,000

Build new drainage for Moormans Arm Road at the intersection of Whites Creek Pike. Improve road drainage at this intersection to alleviate flooding in Haynes Manor.
