## **Taxicab Driver Permit Process**

**New Drivers:** In order to obtain a taxicab driver permit, the following actions must be taken:

- Complete a taxicab driver application.
- Undergo an FBI fingerprint-based identification/criminal background check.
- Obtain a valid Tennessee driver's license with an "F" endorsement (Endorsements A, B, C or CDL are also acceptable).
- Obtain a Motor Vehicle Report (MVR) from the Tennessee Department of Safety (not older than 30 days).
- Submit two color passport size photographs.
- Successfully complete the Taxi Pro School.
- Provide proof of U.S. citizenship or appropriate ICE documentation.
- Taxi Company affiliation form.

**Renewing Drivers:** In order to renew a taxicab driver permit, the following actions must be taken:

- Complete a taxicab driver application.
- (If last fingerprint-based background check was more than 5 years ago) Undergo a FBI fingerprint-based identification/criminal background check.
- Produce a valid Tennessee driver's license with an "F" endorsement (Endorsements A, B, C or CDL are also acceptable).
- Obtain a Motor Vehicle Report (MVR) from the Tennessee Department of Safety (**not** older than 30 days).
- Submit two color passport size photographs.
- Must have attended a Hospitality Training class during the previous permit year.
