




Pick the tree up by the container, not by the tree




CIRCLING ROOTS

Redirect outwards any circling side or bottom roots and separate matted roots. You may have to be tenacious and use a shovel, pick, knife, and hands.



FOR EASE OF REMOVING THE ROOTS FROM THE CONTAINER

Gently roll it on its side. Put pressure on all sides of the container to loosen the inside root ball. This may require a lot of pressure and stomping on it with your feet.



WATER THOROUGHLY AT TIME OF PLANTING. WATER DEEPLY FOR THE NEXT 3 YEARS DURING THE GROWING SEASON AND IN FUTURE TIMES OF DROUGHT.
