PROCUREMENT PROCESS



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- Design and construction of speedway improvements will be competitively procured in accordance with the requirements of the Metro Procurement Code (Title 4 of the Metropolitan Code)
- Bristol Motor Speedway (BMS) will use design-build method



DESIGN-BUILD METHOD

- Design and contractor team are selected at the same time and work together from beginning to end
- Results in a guaranteed maximum price (GMP)
- Promotes efficiency and collaboration
- Common method of project delivery



DESIGN-BUILDER SELECTED THROUGH REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP) PROCESS

- Requires public notice of the RFP to inform prospective contractors of opportunity
- Strict timelines for responses
- Proposals reviewed by an evaluation committee made up of Fair Board, Metro, and BMS officials
 - Similar to evaluation process used for Geodis Park



RFP AWARD

- Awarded to best proposal based upon evaluation factors in RFP
- Price is only one factor, not the determining factor
- Design-builder must be well experienced in comparable projects of this scale
- Design-builder will procure subsequent construction work and materials using bidding or other competitive process consistent with Metro Procurement Code



MINORITY PARTICIPATION

BMS will follow Metro's Procurement Nondiscrimination Program requirements (Chapter 4.46 of the Metropolitan Code)

- Establishes a process for setting participation goals
- Must provide opportunity for minority/women-owned businesses registered with the Metro Business Assistance Office to participate as subcontractors
- BMS will appoint a person experienced in minority contracting and workforce development to monitor minority contractor participation and provide monthly reports to Fair Board



FAIR BOARD COLLABORATION



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- BMS will appoint a Project Manager to oversee the project and communicate regularly with Fair Board
- The Development Agreement provides for a Speedway Oversight Committee (SOC) consisting of Fairgrounds Executive Director, Chair of Fair Board, and Metro Director of Finance or designee to meet regularly with Project Manager during design and construction
- BMS will provide monthly updates to Metro regarding predevelopment expenses (design, engineering, environmental, etc.)



FAIR BOARD COLLABORATION

- Minimum design standards will include fan and driver safety elements, noise abatement features identified in the 2021 noise abatement study, ADA accommodation requirements, and all applicable NASCAR standards
- Design changes cannot fall below these minimum standards
