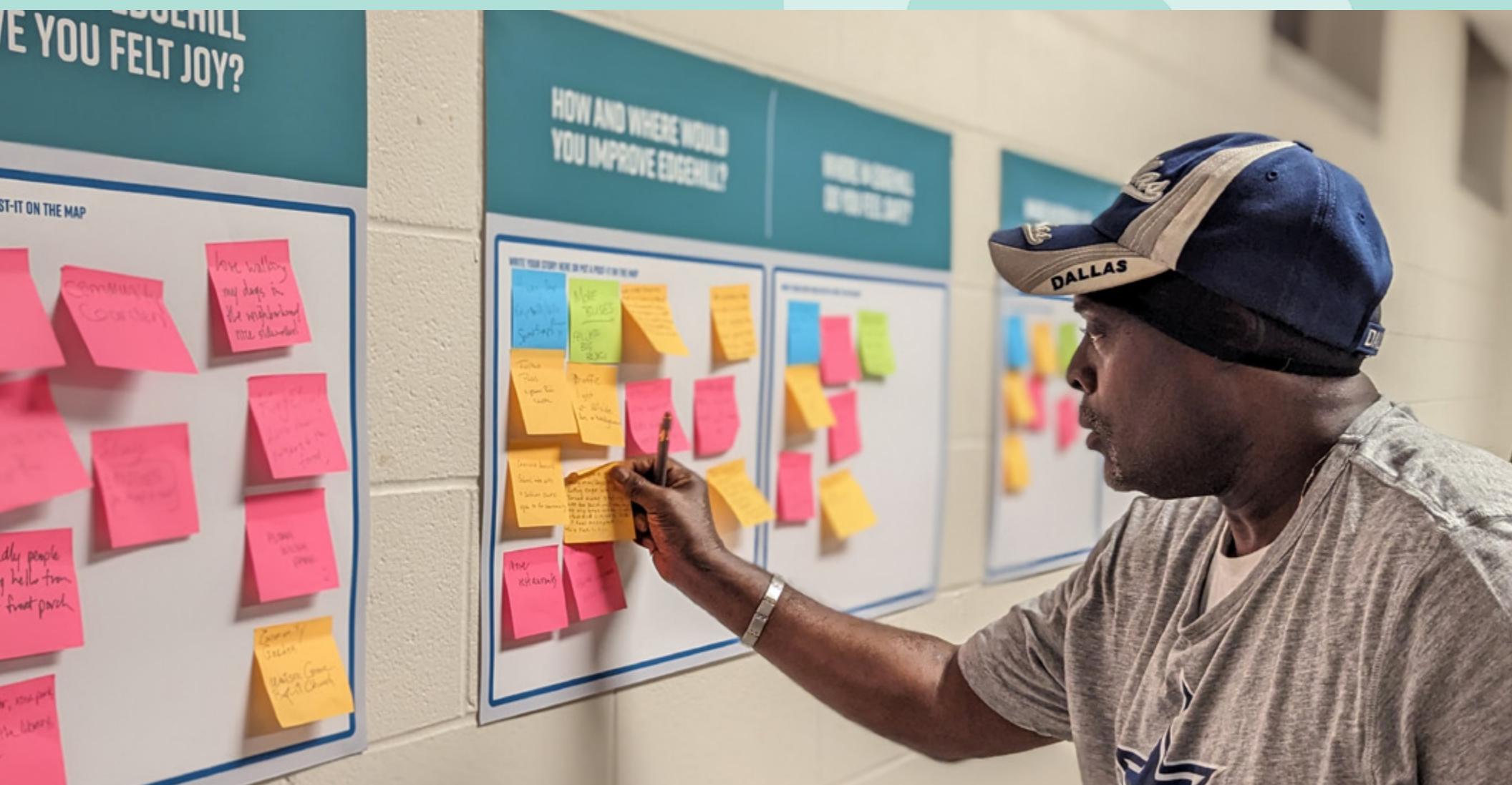

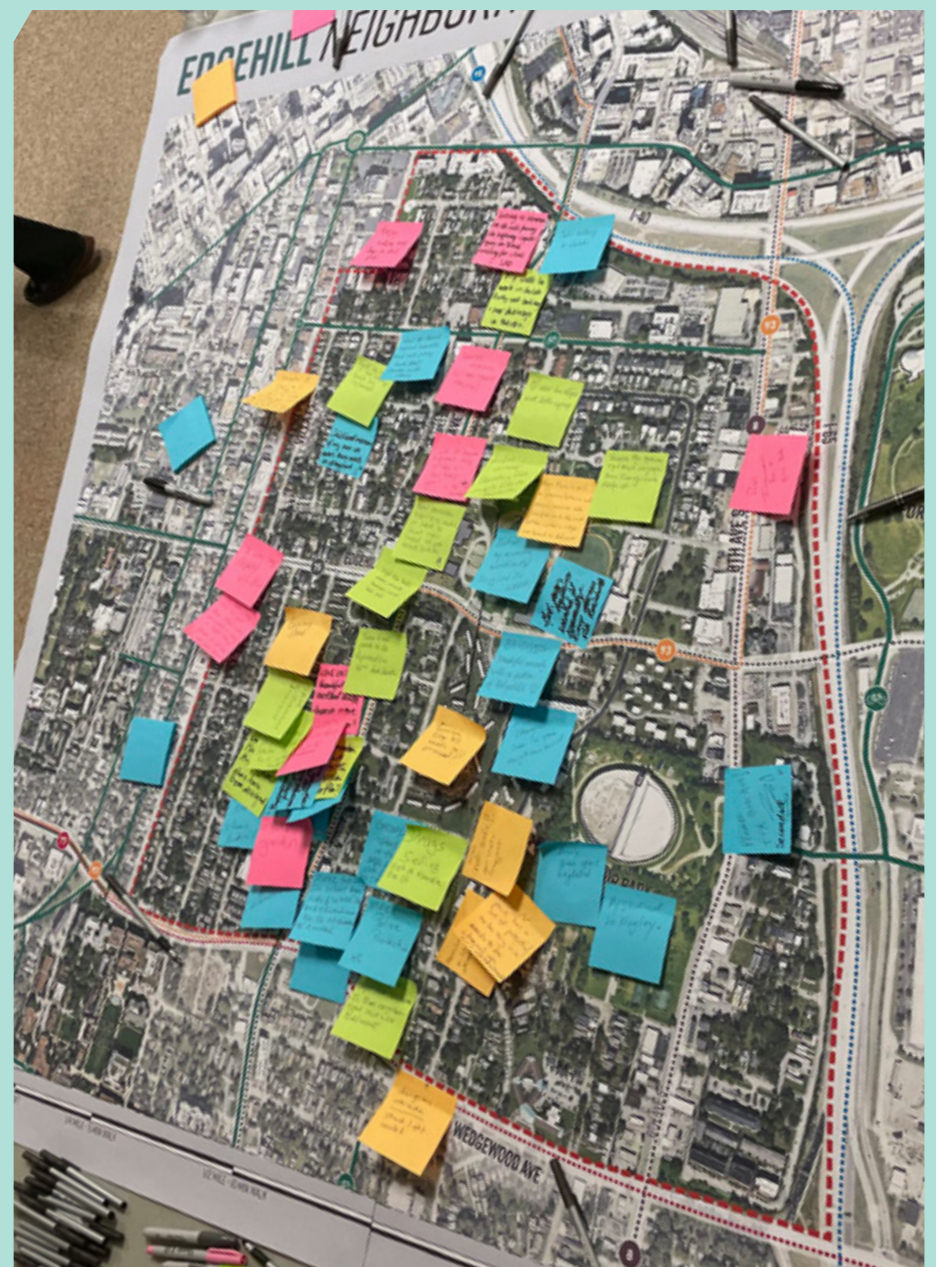
ABOUT THE EDGEHILL NEIGHBORHOOD PLAN

The purpose of the neighborhood plan is to guide growth and development in Edgehill over the next 20 years – in an area bounded generally by Wedgewood Avenue and I-40, I-65 and Villa Place.

The plan seeks to ground itself in the unique role of Edgehill within Nashville: a historic urban center for the African American community, a place deeply affected by the choices of 1960's urban renewal, and a strong neighborhood of active and organized residents.

The six-month process will result in a plan that reflects the goals of the community and clear implementation steps.

Recommendations will include goals for housing, open space, mobility, and economic development that have the potential to help shape future growth in Edgehill, centered around equity and the community's goals.



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
