



MEDIAN HOUSEHOLD INCOME





MEAN HOUSEHOLD INCOME RANGE






PER CAPITA INCOME IN EDGEHILL


















CRASH MAP 2010-2022


- 8th Ave and Wedgewood Ave have more crashes than other roads in the neighborhood.
- A focus on traffic calming at high-crash intersections is likely to yield the greatest reduction in traffic crashes.




DAILY TRAFFIC VOLUMES










"CHARACTER AREAS"


- Identifiable places in Edgehill
