2023 Nashville and Davidson County Participatory Budget Committee Virtual/Zoom Meeting of April 19, 2023

Meeting was called to order by Chair Pastorek at 6:04 PM.

- Chair Pastorek opened the floor to discuss old business
 - o At-Home Reflection
 - Chair Pastorek opened a discussion about defining the guiding principles of the Participatory Budget Committee
 - Egalitarian and inclusivity
 - Draft language was shared by Elizabeth Miller and the following thoughts and comments were shared:
 - Meaningful and long-lasting impact, prioritizing improvements that will last for a long time
 - Inclusive; hear as many voices as possible
 - Practicality of the project(s)
 - Fair, cost-effective, transformative, so everyone "wins," equitable
 - Process and participation as opposed to lasting impact
 - Inclusivity, transparency, equality
 - Unique to Nashville no idea is a bad idea
 - Highlight participation / maximize participation
 - Lasting impact; keep in mind how we can have things that will leave an impact and get individuals invested/excited for future opportunities
 - Process involvement for individuals who otherwise may not have the opportunity or who would otherwise not volunteer
 - Use the process to break down the relational aspects to accomplish wants/needs throughout Davidson County
- Reports and discussions by the subcommittees:
 - Roles and Responsibilities
 - Will spend time making one more pass and present at Saturday's meeting for review with the Steering Committee
 - o Community Engagement
 - Done and in a position that the group can vote
 - Eligibility and Selection
 - Minimum and maximum costs per project: \$300,000 (minimum) \$800,000 (maximum)
 - Facilitator Quinta Martin advised setting a minimum that high will eliminate smaller projects
 - Fabian Bedne respectfully disagreed with Quinta Martin and explained the \$9.3M divided by 35 council districts comes to just over \$250,000 per project
 - Budget
 - Will need a further review after comments from the group at the last meeting and will present again at the next meeting

Voting

- Definition of "resident" and inclusivity especially considering homeless and residents with green card
- Committee was made aware that "Resident" terminology is off-putting to some individuals
- Otherwise can wrap up voting piece and can present Saturday
- Multi-language ballot
- Ballots can be ordered for household members
- Elizabeth advised that after the conversation with Lindsey, she chose the phrase "Community Member" which can be further discussed by the group
- Subcommittees were then permitted to break out into their groups to continue review and revision of their pertinent section of the 2022 Guidelines and were advised to leave the Virtual/Zoom meeting when they had completed their tasks
- Subcommittee members left the meeting as mentioned above; there was no formal adjournment of the meeting.
