


2,383 people experiencing homelessness were housed in Nashville from July 2021 through June 2022.


- Exits to permanent housing destinations from **Emergency Shelters***, **Transitional Housing**, **Street Outreach**, and **Support Services** programs;

- Other exits to permanent housing documented in **Coordinated Entry (CE)** and **Domestic Violence Coordinated Entry (DV CE)****.



Street Outreach



Street Outreach (SO) projects offer services necessary to reach out to people experiencing unsheltered homelessness, connects them to emergency shelters, housing, or other services, and provides urgent non-facility-based care to people unwilling or unable to access emergency shelter or other housing.



- 15 agencies provided Street Outreach services to 1,675 clients (1,589 households) in June.
- 34 clients exited Street Outreach programs to permanent housing destinations in June.
- 2,314 unique clients have been served by Street Outreach projects since July 2021.
- The completeness of this data has fluctuated based on agency participation.

Emergency Shelters

Emergency Shelter (ES) projects offer temporary shelter/lodging for people experiencing homelessness in general or specific populations of people experiencing homelessness.

HMIS-Participating ES Providers:



- 8 agencies provided Emergency Shelter bed services to 180 clients (126 households) in June.
- 16 clients exited Emergency Shelter programs to positive housing destinations in June.
- 1,134 unique clients have been served by Emergency Shelter projects since July 2021.

Transitional Housing




Transitional Housing (TH) projects provide individuals and families experiencing homelessness with the interim stability and support needed to successfully move to and maintain permanent housing.

- 6 agencies provided Transitional Housing services to 205 clients (172 households) in **June**. This data does not include the Nashville Rescue Mission.
- 15 clients exited Transitional Housing programs to positive housing destinations in June.
- 485 unique clients have been served by Transitional Housing programs since July 2021.

Rapid Rehousing

Rapid Rehousing (RRH) projects fund short-or medium-term rental assistance and housing relocation/stabilization services designed to quickly move individuals and families from emergency shelters or places not meant for habitation into permanent housing.



- 11 agencies provided Rapid Rehousing services to 1,319 clients (711 households) in June.
- 625 of those people (311 households) have moved into housing so far.
- 36 clients exited Rapid Rehousing programs to positive housing destinations in June.
- 2,111 unique clients have been served by Rapid Rehousing programs since July 2021.

Permanent Housing




Permanent Housing (PH) projects are community-based housing without a designated length of stay in which formerly homeless individuals and families live as independently as possible. Under PH, a program participant must be the tenant on a lease for an initial term that is renewable. Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH) projects are projects that offer permanent housing and supportive services to assist homeless persons with a disability to live independently.

Homelessness Prevention


Homelessness Prevention (HP) projects fund short-and/or medium-term rental assistance and housing relocation and stabilization services (financial assistance and service costs) designed to prevent an at-risk individual or family from moving into an emergency shelter or place not meant for habitation.

- 9 agencies provided Homelessness Prevention services to 199 clients (94 households) in June.
- 19 clients exited Homelessness Prevention programs to positive housing destinations in June.
- 576 unique clients have been served by HP programs since July 2021.
