2023 Nashville and Davidson County Participatory Budget Committee Meeting of May 13, 2023

Meeting was called to order by Chair Pastorek at 1:09 PM

- Chair Pastorek opened the floor to discuss old business, at-home reflections, and any questions that may have come up since the last meeting
 - Motion was made, seconded, and carried to accept the Minutes of 04/29/2023 and 05/04/2023
 - At-Home Reflection
 - Fabian provided an outreach update which included:
 - social media advertising
 - an upcoming editorial in *The Tennessean*
 - ad installation on WeGo vehicles
 - upcoming in-person presentations throughout Davidson County; and
 - Tiara working on volunteer training
 - Fabian also provided an update on the status of Budget Delegates:
 - 20 delegates have been confirmed
 - Still need candidates for Districts 1, 4, 8, 12, 14, 17, 22, 24, 30, and 35
 - Confirmed the Steering Committee will receive regular email updates from the Budget Delegates Committee
- Subcommittee for **Eligibility and Selection** presented its section of the guidelines for review, comment, and discussion by the Steering Committee Members:
 - Discussion was had regarding the minimum (\$300,000) and maximum (\$800,000) for project funding which will allow approximately 12-16 project proposals to be funded
 - Motion was made, seconded, and carried to eliminate the minimum and maximum project funding in the **Eligibility and Selection** section of the Guidelines
- Steering Committee members were advised the ballot will indicate the idea, cost to complete the idea project, and location of the idea project
- After accepting and approving the **Eligibility and Selection** section of the Guidelines, a motion was made, seconded, and carried to accept the Guidelines as revised by the Steering Committee
- A discussion was had regarding block parties/local events and a budget for such events
 - A motion was made, seconded, and carried to allow a total budget of \$5,000.00, to be applied in the amount of no more than \$500 per event, with a limit of two (2) events per Council District
- Future meetings were discussed by Subcommittee Members
 - June December meet approximately once per month
 - Discussed remote versus virtual meetings
 - Meetings must be published to the public

- June 15 soft hold for the next virtual meeting
- An agenda and/or cancellation must be provided at least 48 hours in advance of the scheduled meeting
- Motion was made, seconded and carried to have once a month virtual meetings with the first meeting being scheduled for Thursday, June 15, 2023
- Jacob Kupin as advised since he is running for Council for his Council District, he can no longer participate as a Steering Committee member and was thanked for his contributions to the group
- Chair Whitney Pastorek advised the Steering Committee she is stepping down as Chair and resigning from the Steering Committee
- Following Chair Pastorke's resignation, a motion was made, seconded, and carried to appoint Jason Sparks as Chair of the Steering Committee
- A motion was then made, seconded, and carried to appoint Gary Schechter Vice Chair of the Steering Committee
- Meeting was adjourned at 2:43 PM.
