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How does this meeting work?

Today's drop-in offers several opportunities to learn more about the site and to share your thoughts and ideas. PROJECT DISPLAYS

Meeting Welcome

- Read a brief overview of the site, what a feasibility study is, what the meeting is about, and review the project schedule

What You Told Us

- Read through the comments made by you and/or others in previous meetings
- Place a sticky note with any comments you believe we missed

Existing Conditions and Existing Building

- Learn about how the building got to its current state and share your stories about the area and site
- See the existing conditions of the building and the site
- Learn what adaptive reuse is
- Review the proposed uses for the building and the site

New Development

- Place a vote on the number of stories you think would be appropriate (NOTE: these votes are only to determine public sentiment)
- Look at nearby building heights and place a sticker where you think development on this site should fit

Next Steps

- Read about the uses that are proposed for the building and the site
- Learn why uses on the site are limited

CONCEPT PLANS

- Sit down at one of the tables with one of our project team members (if others are already seated at the table, don't be shy about joining!)
- Allow the team member to orient you to the site
- Talk through your concerns and what you would like to see
- Write down your comments and leave them on the map
