Never Pour Fats, Oil, or Grease Down the Drain



FOG can cause clogs in household pipes and the sanitary sewer when poured down the drain. These clogs can lead to **sewer overflows** that pollute streams and pose a health risk to people, pets, and wildlife.

Everyone must do their part.



Whether you rent or own, FOG down the drain can lead to sewer backing up into your home.

How can you prevent sewer overflows caused by FOG?

- Pour all used cooking oils and grease into a small container. When the container is full, recycle it, or put the sealed container in your household garbage.
- Dry wipe all pots, pans, and plates before washing in sink or dishwasher. Use paper towels to wipe grease and leftover food into a garbage container.
- Use garbage disposals sparingly since small food and FOG particles from ground material can still clog your pipes and our sewer lines.
