We get questions......

What is my Council district and TN House district?

- Check your voter registration card (printed on white paper) OR
- ➤ Go to Nashville.gov/vote > Find 2023 Election Information > Find My Political Districts OR
- > Call the Election Commission at (615) 862-8800

Why aren't the candidates in the Metropolitan Runoff Election identified by party?

➤ Per T.C.A. 2-13-208, municipal elections are nonpartisan. Consequently, the candidates are not identified by party on the ballot.

Where do I vote on Election Day?

- You must vote at your assigned voting location.
- Check your voter registration card (printed on white paper) OR
- ➤ Go to maps.nashville.gov/PollingPlaceFinder OR
- > Call the Election Commission at (615) 862-8800
- ➤ On Election Day, the polls are open 7am 7pm

What do I need to bring?

- ➤ Voters must present a photo ID issued by the federal or Tennessee state government, unless exemption applies.
- > You do not have to present your voter registration card to vote.

What should I do if something doesn't seem right when I'm voting?

➤ If you have an issue anytime during the process of voting, contact a Poll Official.

Once you insert your marked ballot into the scanner, your vote has been cast.

What if I need to vote by Absentee Ballot?

- Submit your Request Form NOW
- ➤ Go to Nashville.gov/vote > Find 2023 Election Information > Absentee Ballot Request Form September 14, 2023 Elections OR
- > Call the Election Commission at (615) 862-8815
- Last day to request an Absentee Ballot: September 7, 2023
- ➤ Your voted ballot must be received by the Election Commission by 7pm on Election Day.
