Short Description:

Restore the tennis courts at Seven Oaks Park and include striping for pickle ball.

Long Description:

Restore the tennis courts at Seven Oaks Park and add options for pickle ball. The courts are currently unusable because of huge cracks in the pavement. Adding pickle ball options would expand the use and popularity of the courts.

Metro Comments

- Rebuild the courts and take one of the courts and turn those into dedicated pickleball courts. These would have permanent nets for pickleball only.
- Install a fence separating them from Tennis and slats that visually separate them from Tennis. Entrance will be from separate gates.
- There would be 2 tennis courts there also.

This project page has been curated by a budget delegate, drawing inspiration from ideas submitted by Nashville residents until June 20, 2023. It has been shaped with initial input regarding scope and budget from a Metro department. While Metro is committed to adhering to the specified scope, adjustments or even the potential elimination of certain aspects may become necessary during implementation, influenced by site-specific or unforeseen conditions. Furthermore, the projects' funding source is from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), which current guidelines require all ARPA-funded projects be completed by December 2026. Should any project be delayed or expected to be delayed beyond this deadline, it shall be subject to elimination. The implementation timeline will be rigorously monitored to ensure compliance with this crucial requirement. Any prospective alterations to the project will be subjected to rigorous scrutiny and resolution by the steering committee during their regularly scheduled meetings.
