Short Description:

Updates to Sally Beaman Park: Add playground equipment, ADA accessible path and connection to the parking lot.

Long Description:

Funding request to add a playground at Sally Beaman Park, located next to the Green Hills Library at. There is plenty of open land area for a playground while still leaving open field area and without disrupting the existing trails. Adding a playground at this location will not only increase utilization of this park but encourage more children to utilize the library resource and reinforce a sense of community. There is also an added benefit of allowing more outdoor programming for the library. Funding will include an ADA path and parking lot connection.

It has been shaped with initial input regarding scope and budget from a Metro department. While Metro is committed to adhering to the specified scope, adjustments or even the potential elimination of certain aspects may become necessary during implementation, influenced by site-specific or unforeseen conditions. Furthermore, the projects' funding source is from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), which current guidelines require all ARPA-funded projects be completed by December 2026. Should any project be delayed or expected to be delayed beyond this deadline, it shall be subject to elimination. The implementation timeline will be rigorously monitored to ensure compliance with this crucial requirement. Any prospective alterations to the project will be subjected to rigorous scrutiny and resolution by the steering committee during their regularly scheduled meetings.
