Short Description:

Updates to Brookemeade Park: Install pickleball courts, playground equipment, and an accessible path, and extend water and electrical service to the playground.

Long Description:

- Install Pickleball courts in the field that is in the floodplain \$575,000
- Install a 2-12 playground, cost \$500,000
- Install a required path down to that point, cost \$175,000.
- Run Electric and Water down to Playground, cost \$150,000.

This project page has been curated by a budget delegate, drawing inspiration from ideas submitted by Nashville residents until June 20, 2023. It has been shaped with initial input regarding scope and budget from a Metro department. While Metro is committed to adhering to the specified scope, adjustments or even the potential elimination of certain aspects may become necessary during implementation, influenced by site-specific or unforeseen conditions. Furthermore, the projects' funding source is from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), which current guidelines require all ARPA-funded projects be completed by December 2026. Should any project be delayed or expected to be delayed beyond this deadline, it shall be subject to elimination. The implementation timeline will be rigorously monitored to ensure compliance with this crucial requirement. Any prospective alterations to the project will be subjected to rigorous scrutiny and resolution by the steering committee during their regularly scheduled meetings.
