PLEASE HELP US KEEP OUR CITY SAFE AND WALKABLE

Sidewalks are a building block of a well-rounded transportation network and one of the most requested services at the Nashville Department of Transportation and Multimodal Infrastructure. Nashville Department of Transportation (NDOT) is responsible for all aspects of Nashville's sidewalks, from master planning the city's newest projects to repairing damage to our most historic sidewalks. NDOT plays an important role in keeping the sidewalks safe for all pedestrians and strollers & ADA compliant.

As such, no person shall stop, stand or park any wagon, pushcart, platform, table, automobile, truck or other vehicle, or erect any temporary or permanent stands, signs (including A-frame signs) for the purpose of selling or offering for sale any goods, service, food, wares, merchandise or products of any kind, nor shall any person sell or offer for sale, upon or within any public property of the metropolitan government, any goods, food, wares, merchandise or products of any kind.

NDOT doesn't allow privately provided signage for the valet zones on street, unless they are the official street signs in compliance with the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) deployed by NDOT.
