An ordinance amending Section 2.78.010 of the Metropolitan Code of Laws to authorize the Board of Fair Commissioners ("the Fair Board") to adopt rules and regulations to provide for sponsorships of the divisional fair, expo center events, flea markets, auto racing, and other programs, events, projects, facilities, and sites at The Fairgrounds Nashville ("the Fairgrounds").
ursuant to Chapter 490 of the Acts of Tennessee for 1909, Chap

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 490 of the Acts of Tennessee for 1909, Chapter 515 of the Private Acts of 1923, as amended, and Metropolitan Charter Section 11.602, the Fair Board must operate a divisional fair, expo center events, flea markets, and auto racing; and,

WHEREAS, the Fair Board desires to enter into sponsorship agreements with corporations, non-profits, and other organizations, to defray capital and/or operating costs; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County that this ordinance be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1: That Section 2.78.010 of the Metropolitan Code of Laws is hereby amended by adding the following subsection D to Section 2.78.010:

D. The fair board is authorized to adopt rules and regulations to provide for sponsorship of the divisional fair, expo center events, flea markets, auto racing, and other programs, events, projects, facilities, and sites at The Fairgrounds Nashville. Such rules and regulations shall include, but not be limited to, the types of events, programs, facilities, and sites that may be sponsored; the size, number, and placement of sponsor signs; the use of logos; and the types of industries and products that are not eligible for sponsorship. The fair board shall have the authority to enter into sponsorship agreements with a total net value not to exceed twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000). All sponsorship agreements with a total net value in excess of \$25,000 must be approved by resolution adopted by the metropolitan council.

Section 2: That this ordinance shall take effect from and after its final passage, the welfare of the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.
