Appeal of Decisions

Pursuant to the provisions of § 2.68.030 of the Metropolitan Code of Laws, please take notice that decisions of the Sports Authority Board may be appealed to the Chancery Court of Davidson County for review under a common law writ of certiorari. Any appeal must be filed within sixty days after entry of a final decision by the Board. Any person or other entity considering an appeal should consult with an attorney to ensure that time and procedural requirements are met.

Public Comment

Effective July 1, 2023, members of the public in attendance will have the opportunity to make comments to the Authority on **items on this agenda** to which the Authority will **take action**. Comments will be limited to two (2) minutes per person with a maximum of ten (10) speakers. Those desiring to speak shall submit a written request to sports.authority@nashville.gov at least forty-eight (48) hours prior to the meeting identifying the reason for the request, the agenda topic(s) they wish to speak on and whether they are "for" or "against" such item(s). In addition to prior notice, intended speakers also must sign up on a dedicated sign-in sheet at least five minutes prior to the scheduled start of meeting. Intended speakers are strongly encouraged to review the Authority's policy at Public Comment Policy for additional details.
