



As a woman I feel very unsafe now on this street, those two bars need to be shut down and this street needs to be cleaned back up from this violence these two bars have brought in!
- 17. Scooters are left all over the sidewalk resulting in a severe tripping hazard. Business owners should be required to pick up trash in front of their establishment."
- 18. As a condo owner in this area we do use the street parking for guests. Our major concern is safety while walking pets in the evening. Speeding on the street in crosswalks, etc. Safety of the street in general at night is an issue!! Thank you.

Additionally, at all hours of the day and night, deliveries and pickups block the line of sight by the only crosswalk on the strip. This blocked sight line means that pedestrians and oncoming vehicles cannot see each other until it's almost too late to take action.
